Coli, Salmonellosis, Shigellosis Influenza-Like Illness, Syphilis, Chlamydia, & Gonorrhea, only confirmed cases (as defined by National Surveillance Case Definitions: http://wwwn.cdc.gov/nndss/script/casedefDefault.aspx) are included.
