Presentations will include:

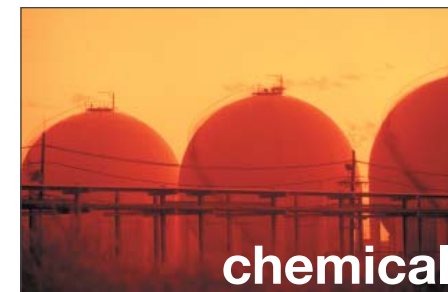

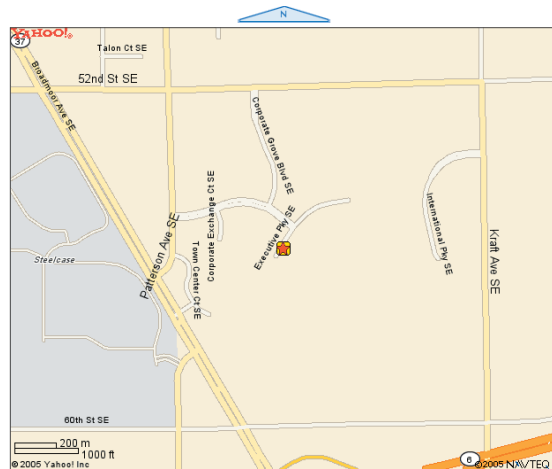
