To the Kent County Drain Commissioner:



The Lamberton Creek Drain Drainage District is located in the City of Grand Rapids, Grand Rapids Township, and Plainfield Township, Kent County, Michigan.

The proposed maintenance and improvement is necessary for the public health, convenience or welfare and benefits the public health in the City of Grand Rapids.

The City of Grand Rapids will be liable for an assessment at large against it for a percentage of the cost of the proposed maintenance and improvement.



WHEREAS:

1. The City of Grand Rapids, Michigan, is a Michigan municipal entity ("City"); and
2. The City acting by and through its legislative body, the City Commission, recognizes that it is necessary and conducive for the public health to conduct maintenance and improvements of the Lamberton Creek Drain, located in Kent County, pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended; and
3. The City recognizes that it will be subject to an assessment at large to pay for a percentage of the cost of the proposed maintenance and improvements; therefore

RESOLVED:

1. That the City Commission authorizes and approves the filing of a petition for the maintenance and improvement of the Lamberton Creek Drain.
2. That the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the petition in substantially the form attached as Exhibit A and to approve such changes in, and modifications to, the Petition consistent with this Resolution that do not materially adversely affect the City and as approved by the City Engineer and the City Attorney.
3. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby rescinded.
