As petitioner, you must provide the Petition and Notice of Hearing to the persons listed below at least fourteen (14) days prior to the hearing if served by mail or seven (7) days prior to the hearing if served personally:

- [ ] The respondent (i.e. the person in need of protection)
- [ ] The respondent's spouse, children and descendants of pre-deceased children
- [ ] If the respondent has a spouse, but no children or grandchildren, the respondent's parents and spouse
- [ ] If no spouse, children or grandchildren, the respondent's parents.
- [ ] If the respondent has no spouse, child, grandchild or parent living, the presumptive heirs of the respondent, considered in the following order, must be served:
  - **Siblings.** If the respondent has no descendants and both parents are deceased, then the respondent's brothers and sisters;
  - **Nieces and Nephews.** If the respondent has no descendants and both parents are deceased, and the respondent had a brother or sister who passed away, and that brother or sister left children of his/her own, then the respondent's nieces and nephews;
  - **Grandparents.** If the respondent has no descendants, both parents are deceased, and there are no brothers or sisters or descendants of brothers and sisters, then the respondent's grandparents;
  - **Descendants of Grandparents.** If the respondent's grandparents are deceased, any uncles or aunts, or children of deceased uncles or aunts, would be considered the respondent's presumptive heirs;
  - **Attorney General.** If there are no presumptive heirs, then the State of Michigan is the respondent's presumptive heir, and the Michigan Attorney General must be served at the following address:

- [ ] The nominated conservator
- [ ] If known, the named agent under a durable power of attorney
- [ ] A governmental agency paying benefits to the individual to be protected or before which an application for benefits is pending
- [ ] If known, a guardian or conservator appointed by a court in another state to manage the respondent's finances
