- Preserved in 2007
- Field Crop Production
- Tim Heffron of H & W Farm Market in Grattan Township operates this farm for his mother.
- H & W Market features the family's cherry juice as well as many other Michigan grown products.
- Crops from the preserved farm are used for:
 - Feed for Herburck's egg production
 - Processed for cooking oil and livestock feed by Zeeland Farm Services
 - Processed for Ethanol production by the Woodbury ethanol plant and DDGs are then used for livestock feed.
- Supported by: Grattan Township, Steelcase Foundation, Wege Foundation, Urban Cooperation Board, USDA Farm and Ranch Land Protection Program.
- Development rights cost: \$4,326 per acre
