Disability Advocates had 2 new Veteran referrals for March. Our Occupational Therapists have completed a total of 6 home assessments so far this year. We continue to work with contractors on getting bids for needed modifications. We provided a reacher in the home to one of the Veterans. This is the only equipment issued this month. We had a spouse of a Veteran come into the Home Accessibility Center to plan for their bathroom modifications.

So far in 2023 we have not provided any modifications: we did provide adaptive equipment to 2 Veterans. We have some home modifications in the planning and bidding process.

We had 6 new information and referral calls from Veterans in Kent County during March, with a total of 17 for 2023.

We continue to partner with other community agencies in our efforts. Senior Neighbors, Home Repair Services, Building Bridges, and several contractors have assisted in making these homes safe and accessible for our Veterans. Disability Advocates also uses vendors such as Carelinc and Advantage Ramps. We are currently getting a bid from Lakeshore Barrier Free, and are looking for bids for flooring, possibly Re-floor.
