Except for Chickenpox, Campylobacter, Coronavirus, Cryptosporidiosis, Shiga-Toxin Producing E. Coli, Salmonellosis, Shigellosis, Influenza-Like Illness, Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, and Syphilis only confirmed cases (as defined by National Surveillance Case Definitions: http://wwwn.cdc.gov/nndss/script/casedefDefault.aspx) are included.
