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Push Partner Activation for Pandemic Influenza Vaccine

The Kent County Health Department (KCHD) is activating the Push Partner Registry to distribute pandemic influenza vaccine to the priority groups specified by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). Groups that are eligible to receive pandemic influenza at this time are:

- Front-line inpatient and hospital-based health care workers
- Front-line outpatient health care providers
