He is wanted on the following charges:

- Parole Violation
- Criminal Sexual Conduct 1<sup>st</sup> Degree and Criminal Sexual Conduct 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree (Person under 13 Years Old)
- Fleeing and Eluding a Police Officer
- Habitual Offender 4<sup>th</sup> Offense

On February 18, 2018, Deputies attempted to arrest Perry on the Parole Violation when he fled in his vehicle driving the wrong way on Broadmoor Ave S.E. at excessive speeds. The pursuit was terminated due to the risk. Perry abandoned his vehicle in Caledonia, was picked up by an acquaintance, and dropped off in the City of Kentwood. It is unknown if he has access to another vehicle.

Perry served time in prison for Assault by Strangulation and was paroled on 6/27/2017. Perry has a prior conviction for Criminal Sexual Conduct 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree (Person under 13 Years Old).
