On 6/22/18 we were dispatched to 2365 84th St SW (Huntington Bank) on a report of an armed bank robbery. The male suspect entered the bank and as he approached the teller window he drew a nickel color revolver, pointed it at the teller, and demanded money. The suspect is described as a medium to larger build male, unknown ethnicity, wearing a Vans brand hat ("Vans" in white lettering on front), glasses or sunglasses, a dark bandana, a grey or blue long sleeve shirt with a black short sleeve over shirt, khaki cargo shorts, and bright white shoes. The suspect fled the bank with an unknown amount of cash and rode a bicycle to the northeast where he is believed to have gotten into a maroon Chrysler Pacifica which then left the area northbound on Byron Center. There were no injuries reported.

Response efforts were coordinated with the FBI who also responded to the scene and will be handling the investigation from this point forward.
