On July 28th at around 2315 hours the Kent County Sheriff's Office responded to a personal injury accident involving two passenger vehicles. The accident occurred at the intersection of 7 Mile Rd NW and Bristol Ave NW in Alpine Township.

Preliminary investigation revealed that a 1986 Oldsmobile, driven by a 50-year-old female, was traveling north on Bristol Ave NW. The other driver of a 2016 Ford Flex, a 40-year-old female, was travelling west on 7 Mile Rd NW with a 47-year-old male passenger, and four children between the ages of 6 and 15. After the vehicles collided within the intersection, one of the vehicles was redirected into a residence on the northwest corner. There was damage to the residence, but no one inside was injured. It is still under investigation if alcohol or drugs was a factor.

Only minor injuries were reported to the children. The injury status of the adults is still unknown at this time. The Kent County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Alpine Township Fire Department and Life Ambulance.
