Kent County Finance & Physical Resources Committee Using Teleconference Capacity

GRAND RAPIDS, Mich. (April 20, 2020) — Kent County will use a teleconference meeting option for its Finance & Physical Resources (FPR) Committee on Tuesday, April 21, 2020 at 8:30 a.m.

On March 13, 2020, Governor Whitmer issued Executive Order No. 2020-48 using the powers of the state of emergency declaration to allow virtual public meetings. In the Order, it states:

“All public bodies of departments and agencies of the State subject to the Open Meetings Act that must continue to meet must do so by means sufficient to enable meaningful access and communication for all participants. Participation by remote technology, including conference calling, real-time streaming, or other platforms is acceptable, and sufficient to form a quorum, so long as public access and participation is preserved.”
