KCCA Announces Food Distribution Amid COVID-19 Pandemic

GRAND RAPIDS, Mich. (June 3, 2020) – On Thursday, June 4, 2020, the Kent County Community Action (KCCA) is holding a food distribution event in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The event will be held from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for low-income residents at the DeltaPlex Arena, 2500 Turner Ave. NW, Walker. Vehicles should enter at the West River Drive entrance.

Attendees are asked to remain in their vehicle and have their trunks open and ready to accept 75 pounds of food. This will enable the distribution to operate efficiently and ensure the safety of staff.

“This distribution event is our way to respond to the COVID-19 crisis and help to alleviate the causes of poverty,” said Susan Cervantes, KCCA Director.

This event will assist more than 1,200 households struggling to meet their food insecurities caused by COVID-19, which is an increase of 200 households from the previous two distribution events.

There will be more than 20 food items in the packet including, but not limited to, fresh apples and oranges, canned vegetables and fruits, spaghetti noodles, frozen pork, and beef.
