# How to add exceptions to your pop-up blocker

## Chrome

#### Follow these steps:

- 1. Click the Chrome menu on the browser toolbar.
- 2. Select Settings.
- 3. Click Show advanced settings.
- 4. in the "Privacy" section, click the Content settings button.

5. In the "Pop-ups" section, select "Allow all sites to show pop-ups." Customize permissions for specific websites by clicking Manage exception

# Firefox

#### Follow these steps:

- 1. Click the menu button  $\equiv$  and choose Options.
- 2. Select the Privacy & Security panel.
- Under the **Permissions** section,
- Click on Exceptions... opens a dialog box with a list of sites that you want to allow to display pop-ups.
