

**KENT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
PUBLIC COMMENT PROCEDURES**

1. A person wishing to address the Board is requested to state his or her name and address.
2. A person may address the Board on matters or issues which are relevant to County government. The Chair may disallow public comment that is unduly repetitious, not relevant to County government or matters not under consideration by the Board. The Chair may limit the time each person is allowed to speak during public comment. However, the time for public comment may not be limited to less than three minutes.
3. Ordinarily, an individual has one, five-minute opportunity to speak during each public comment on the agenda, *unless otherwise limited by the Chair*.
4. When a group wishes to address the Board, the Chair may offer that group designate a spokesperson. The Chair will control the amount of time the spokesperson will be allowed to speak which will not exceed 15 minutes.

DECORUM

Please respect the order and decorum of the meeting by avoiding vulgarity, insults and inflammatory language.
